BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES INFORMATION

Sweepstakes Point Payback Prize Money is available at every AHA recognized event.* Do you have a horse enrolled as an Original Entry, Breeding Entry, Gelding Entry or Yearling Entry? Then your horse is eligible to receive Sweepstakes prize money in Sweepstakes designated classes through the Points Payback Program. Simply enroll your horse before the first date of competition for \$100 to start accumulating points to be paid back at the end of the competition year.

How points will be paid out.

AHA recognized Shows and Events will receive 55% of the total collected funds will be paid. Total points earned each year in designated Sweepstakes Classes and sides will be divided into the 55% to determine dollar value per point. AHA will issue a check to the recorded owner of the horse (as of December 31 of the competition year) based on show and ride results for that year.

Sweepstakes Point Program

This is an optional program when all Sweepstakes requirements are met. Sweepstakes Nominated Horses must be enrolled in the Points Program in order to be eligible for prize money payout. Enrollments must be made on-line or postmark/electronic transaction dated to the AHA office before the first day of the event. Event management may not accept Sweepstakes Point Program Enrollment.

25. P.A. SYSTEM Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the P.A. System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible for having his horse at the gate at the prescribed time.

26. PRIZE MONEY AND AWARDS: Prize money will be distributed at the show. Prize Money will be applied to amount due first, if no fees are due then prize money will be awarded as cash at time of check out.

27. PROTESTS: may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred; accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 if made by an USEF Member or \$300 if made by a Non-Member; (if check, payable to the competition). It must be received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager of the competition or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. GR 603

28. REFUNDS: After September 17th, 2010 entry and stall fees will not be refunded for horses entered and not exhibited, except in case of written request accompanied by a Veterinarian's Certificate written on said Veterinarian's letterhead. Exhibitors must notify the Show Secretary of cancellations prior to the time the class is called. Office fees are non-refundable.

29. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., (or in the case of a foreign entry, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Registry of America), and/or the Canadian Horse Registry, or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for (Exception: AR 236.1) and must be entered in their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. A copy of the registration papers will be returned when exhibitors pick up their numbers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age that are eligible for registry and registration applied for). Horses shown in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a Certificate of Registration from AHA in the Half-Arabian Registry or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have a CPAR permit. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and applied for registration. (Only weanlings who have applied for registration may show without papers.) The horse must be entered under its full registered name. Half-Arabian colts/stallions two years and older may not compete in Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian in hand classes. (Refer to USEF rules) committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the Show.

30. RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks. **31. SECURITY** In the event you should have an emergency call 911

32. STALLS: ALL STALLS WILL BE RESERVED AS PAYMENT IS RECEIVED-NO STALL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT. All stall reservations MUST be made with the Show Secretary. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must submit entries together. Exhibitors will be responsible for cost in repairing any damage or alterations to stalls. Stalls doors are provided. NO BEDDING IS PROVIDED. THE USE OF STRAW AS BEDDING IS PROHIBITED.

Stalls are available at 9AM the day before the first class starts. Earlier arrivals must contact the barn manager at to arrange for their assigned stalls to be unlocked.

17. FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering an Federation-Licensed Competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of the Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 1502.5

18. HOOF LENGTH AND SHOE Requirements: See the current USEF Rule Book for shoeing requirements on Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses.

19. JUDGES: In the event of failure of a judge to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge.

20. JUDGING SYSTEM All Purebred Arabian and HA/AA In-Hand and Breeding classes will be judged using the AHA approved Scoring System and Ring Procedures. The Breeding and In-Hand classes will use the In-Ring Procedure. Total points from the "designated classes" will determine the Champion and Reserve Champion Breeding or In-Hand Classes. All Sport Horse In-Hand classes will be judged using the AHA approved Sport Horse Judging System.

21. MEMBERSHIPS: Memberships are required of all exhibitors in AHA and USEF. See the Entry Blank for details or page 4

22. MINORS: *Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.*

23. NO SHOW FEE: Scratches must be reported to the show office or the paddock master before the beginning of the class. If scratches are not reported, a \$5.00 "NO SHOW" fee will be assessed. This fee will be assessed each time there is a "NO SHOW."

24. NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASS: Five or more entries constitute a class. If a class has fewer than five entries, the class may be canceled or combined.

3. AMATEUR STATUS: Every rider/handler having reached his 18th birthday by December 1, of previous year, must possess a current USEF Amateur Certification or be eligible for and have made application of one with the Competition Secretary at least one hour prior to exhibiting in an Amateur Class.

4. AMATEUR OWNERS: Combined ownership is not permitted in Owner or Amateur Owner Classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Horses sold on Contract or Leased horses are not eligible.

5. ASTM HEADGEAR: Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all riders in Hunter Seat Equitation sections or Hunter Hack must wear properly fitting protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitting.

6. BICYCLES, MOTORBIKES, CHILD SCOOTER BOARDS and ROLLERBLADES are prohibited. (See Minors) This rule will be ENFORCED.

7. CALL FOR CLASSES: 2 MINUTES will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. This limit will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

8. CAMPER REGULATIONS: (\$15.00 per night) Payable to the show office.

9. COGGINS TEST REQUIRED: A certificate of a negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia (dated within 12 months of the show dates) is required for horses residing outside Indiana. Out of state horses must also have a current (30 day) health certificate.

10. CONDUCT Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges/Officials on the part of the owner, trainer, rider or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited. The Show Committee also bears the responsibility to aid the judges in avoiding contact with exhibitors or their agents before and during the show.

11. COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS: Must be submitted for each horse with the entry form. They will be returned at the show.

12. CROSS ENTRIES Cross entries are prohibited between the Country English Pleasure sections and the English Pleasure sections at the same show

13. DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS: All horses entering any licensed U. S. Equestrian show will be charged \$7.00 drug fee per horse + \$5 U. S. Equestrian fee to defray the expense of testing and administration. (See Exceptions) All horses on the grounds will be subject to drug testing throughout the show.

14. NO POST ENTRY FEES:

15. ENTRIES: No entry will be processed nor stalls assigned unless a correctly completed entry form duly signed is accompanied by check or money order for full payment of fees. Payment may be made by check or money order. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agent.

16. EXHIBITOR CHECKOUT: When an exhibitor is ready to leave the show, they must check out at the show office and settle their account.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. **EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

RESPONSIBILITY: The Indiana Arabian Horse Club, INC accepts no responsibility for loss or destruction of property or equipment not owned by them or for damages to or by animals on exhibition at this show grounds or stabling areas. Show management will have the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA rules. The sponsoring clubs recommend that all exhibitors become members of the USEF organization. Members receive a complete rulebook for reference when competing in shows. Membership information and application can be found in this premium list. Special emphasis will be placed on rules pertaining to retention of natural action. Leg chains rattlers or other artificial appliances on a horse's leg while on show grounds will be cause for immediate removal from the show and all winnings forfeited. To make the show more enjoyable for all concerned, exhibitors are encouraged to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, adhering to all rules and regulations. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Intoxication, disrespect for rules, undue punishment or mishandling of a horse at the discretion of the Judge and/or Show Committee will be liable to disqualification for events and cancellation of awards without claims for damages.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the show,

1. ADMISSION TO ARENA: No person will be permitted to enter the arena except class participants, judges and other assistants, show photographers and show management personnel. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the judge. HEADERS are permitted in all driving classes and Walk-Trot/Jog classes, but MUST be properly attired in a plain white smock.

2. AGE OF INDIVIDUALS: For horse show purposes, an individual's age on December 1 of the previous year shall be maintained throughout the entire year. Persons born December 1 shall assume the greater age of that date.

"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH"

All exhibitors entered in this event must be a current AHA member or pay the Single event Membership (except see above re: Regional classes). This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.

WARNING Under Indiana law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

INTERNATIONAL ARABIAN BREEDER'S SWEEPSTAKES

At Local shows any exhibitor may enter and compete in IABS classes. All entries will be counted for points. Points will count only for exhibitors enrolled in the Sweepstakes Point Program before the show starts.

2011 AHA Medal Class Specifications

If a show offers any or all of the AHA Medal Classes, the following specifications must be printed in the prize list.

- AHA Hunter Seat Over Obstacles Medal class.**
 - a. To be shown over a course of not fewer than six obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3' of which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead).
 - b. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Equitation Division EQ 113 - Tests 1 -7, 9-15, 17-19 (EC equivalent).
- AHA Saddle Seat Medal class.**
 - a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests (EQ 120) 1-15 (EC equivalent). Markers shall not be used. USEF Test 16 may only be called for at the National Shows.
- AHA Reining Seat Medal class.**
 - a. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining Division (EC equivalent).
 - b. Order of go will be done by draw.
 - c. Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all riders must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
 - d. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
 - e. In the event the total score is tied, the tie will first be broken by the exhibitor with the highest equitation score. Should a tie still exist, the tie shall be broken by reining rules in RN 103.2.
 - f. It is mandatory that judges use the prescribed AHA Score Sheet for Reining Seat Equitation and that the score sheet or a copy be posted immediately after each class.
- AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class.**
 - a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more tests from USEF Equitation Division, EQ 113. Tests From Which Judges Must Choose.
- AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class.**
 - a. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division, Subchapter Western Horsemanship, AR-26.
