FROM THE NORTH – Take US 31 South, turn Left on West 3rd Street, 1/2 mile from US 31.

FROM THE SOUTH/INDIANAPOLIS – Take US 31 North, turn Right on West 3rd Street, 1/2 mile from US 31.

FROM THE EAST VIA FORT WAYNE – Take SR 14 West, turn right on Main Street, turn Left on 3th Street.

OR

Take SR 14 West to SR 25 South, merge on to US 31 North, turn Right on West 3rd Street, 1/2 mile from US 31.

FROM THE WEST – Take SR 14 EAST, turn left at S Meridian Rd .5 mi, turn right at E 50N, turn left at US-31N 1mi, right at CR 150N, slight left at W 3rd St.

22. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., (or in the case of a foreign entry, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Registry of America), and/or the Canadian Horse Registry, or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for (Exception: AR 236.1) and must be entered in their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers.) A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. A copy of the registration papers will be returned when exhibitors pick up their numbers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age that are eligible for registry and registration applied for).

Horses shown in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a Certificate of Registration from AHA in the Half-Arabian Registry or the Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have a CPAR permit. If under one year of age, the horse must be eligible for registry and applied for registration. (Only weanlings who have applied for registration may show without papers.) The horse must be entered under its full registered name. Half-Arabian colts/stallions two years and older may not compete in Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian in hand classes. (Refer to USEF rules) committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the Show.

23. RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks.

24. SECURITY In the event you should have an emergency call 911

25. STALLS: ALL STALLS WILL BE RESERVED AS PAYMENT IS RECEIVED-NO STALL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT. All stall reservations MUST be made with the Show Secretary. **Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must submit entries together.** Exhibitors will be responsible for cost in repairing any damage or alterations to stalls. Stalls doors are provided. NO BEDDING IS PROVIDED. THE USE OF STRAW AS BEDDING IS PROHIBITED.

Stalls will be available beginning Friday May 20th at 9AM. Earlier arrivals must contact the barn manager at to arrange for their assigned stalls to be unlocked.

AHA MEDAL CLASS RULES

1. Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th Birthday.

b. Saddle Seat: following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF EQ 119, Tests 1-15

d. Hunter Seat Not to Jump: following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Art. 1336.92. For an AHA Medal to be awarded three (3) competitors with proper appointments must compete.

e. Horsemanship: following the rail work all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR 215.

All exhibitors entered in this event must be a current AHA member or pay the Single event Membership. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.

WARNING Under Indiana law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

9. HOOF LENGTH AND SHOE Requirements: See the current USEF Rule Book for shoeing requirements on Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses.

10. JUDGES: In the event of failure of a judge to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge.

11. JUDGING SYSTEM All Purebred Arabian and HA/AA In-Hand and Breeding classes will be judged using the AHA approved Scoring System and Ring Procedures. The Breeding and In-Hand classes will use the In-Ring Procedure. Total points from the "designated classes" will determine the Champion and Reserve Champion Breeding or In-Hand Classes.

12. MEMBERSHIPS: Memberships are required of all exhibitors in AHA. See the Entry Blank for details or page 4

13. MINORS: *Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.*

14. NO SHOW FEE: Scratches must be reported to the show office or the paddock master before the beginning of the class. If scratches are not reported, a \$5.00"NO SHOW" fee will be assessed. This fee will be assessed each time there is a "NO SHOW."

15. COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS: Must be submitted for each horse with the entry form. They will be returned at the show.

16. CROSS ENTRIES Cross entries are prohibited between the Country English Pleasure sections and the English Pleasure sections at the same show

17. POST ENTRY FEES : No Post Entry fees will be assessed.

18. ENTRIES: No entry will be processed nor stalls assigned unless a correctly completed entry form duly signed is accompanied by check or money order for full payment of fees. Payment may be made by check or money order. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agent.

19. EXHIBITOR CHECKOUT: When an exhibitor is ready to leave the show, they must check out at the show office and settle their account.

20. P.A. SYSTEM Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the P.A. System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible for having his horse at the gate at the prescribed time.

21. REFUNDS: After May 10th, 2011 entry and stall fees will not be refunded for horses entered and not exhibited, except in case of written request accompanied by a Veterinarian's Certificate written on said Veterinarian's letterhead. Exhibitors must notify the Show Secretary of cancellations prior to the time the class is called. Office fees are non-refundable.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

RESPONSIBILITY: The Indiana Arabian Horse Club, INC accepts no responsibility for loss or destruction of property or equipment not owned by them or for damages to or by animals on exhibition at this show grounds or stabling areas. Show management will have the responsibility of enforcing all AHA rules. Special emphasis will be placed on rules pertaining to retention of natural action. Leg chains rattlers or other artificial appliances on a horse's leg while on show grounds will be cause for immediate removal from the show and all winnings forfeited. To make the show more enjoyable for all concerned, exhibitors are encouraged to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, adhering to all rules and regulations. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Intoxication, disrespect for rules, undue punishment or mishandling of a horse at the discretion of the Judge and/or Show Committee will be liable to disqualification for events and cancellation of awards without claims for damages.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the show,

1. ADMISSION TO ARENA: No person will be permitted to enter the arena except class participants, judges and other assistants, show photographers and show management personnel. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the judge. HEADERS are permitted in all driving classes and Walk-Trot/Jog classes, but MUST be properly attired in a plain white smock.

2. AGE OF INDIVIDUALS: For horse show purposes, an individual's age on December 1 of the previous year shall be maintained throughout the entire year. Persons born December 1 shall assume the greater age of that date.

3. ASTM HEADGEAR: Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all riders in Hunter Seat Equitation sections or Hunter Hack must wear properly fitting protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitting.

4. BICYCLES, MOTORBIKES, CHILD SCOOTER BOARDS and ROLLERBLADES are prohibited. (See Minors) This rule will be **ENFORCED**.

5. CALL FOR CLASSES: 2 MINUTES will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. This limit will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

6. CAMPER REGULATIONS: (\$10.00 per night) Payable to the show office.

7. COGGINS TEST REQUIRED: A certificate of a negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia (dated within 12 months of the show dates) is required for horses residing outside Indiana. Out of state horses must also have a current (30 day) health certificate.

8. CONDUCT Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges/Officials on the part of the owner, trainer, rider or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited. The Show Committee also bears the responsibility to aid the judges in avoiding contact with exhibitors or their agents before and during the show.

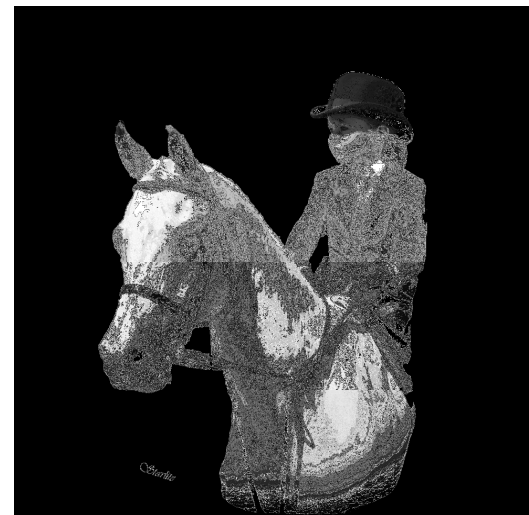
